Course Overview

The course focus is Media Studies Level 8 of the New Zealand Curriculum.

You will gain knowledge, skills and experience to *evaluate* and then *apply understanding* of:

- media concepts
- language in media texts
- the relationship between media and society/industry
- media conventions and technology to create media



Learning pathway

You will co-construct an individualized programme with Ms Morgan according to learning needs and goals. The key goals for this class are:

- providing a pathway to Scholarship Media Studies, tertiary study and work
- developing a critical understanding of the key media concepts
- strengthening multi literacies:
 - confidence in writing a range of genre (eg: script, discursive essay, report)
 - close and critical reading
